

## Exeter Township Supervisors Hearings on 7/18/2006

The Exeter Township Supervisors held two hearings on 7/18/2006.

Dave Barbieri was absent for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in 20 meetings in 2006.

1. The owner of Alebrije Mexican Grill asked the supervisors to allow him to seek a liquor license for the restaurant. The supervisors approved his request with the following condition:
  - a. Liquor cannot be served or consumed outside the establishment
  
2. Developer Charles Leazier of Leazier Homes requested a waiver for curbs and sidewalks on Royal View Estates.
  - a. The Engineer for the developer explained that the five-lot subdivision would fit better with the rural character of the surrounding neighborhood without sidewalks and curbs.
  - b. Planning Commissioner, Paul Schwartz, had told the developer that he would make sure the plan would not go through because it was not in accordance with Exeter Township ordinances.
  - c. Dr. Ganas, Chairman of the Exeter Township Supervisors, stated that the Planning Commission is only an advisory committee and the Supervisors would make the final decision within 45 days.
