

Exeter Township Re-Organization Meeting Held January 3, 2006 (Summary)

The meeting was called to order with the all five (5) supervisors in attendance. There were nine (9) residents of Exeter Township present to witness the re-organization. Supervisor Michelle Kircher was present, having been newly elected, and replaced former Supervisor Lachlan MacBean.

The first order of business was the election of Temporary Chairman and Secretary. Tom Klonis and Troy Bingamin following 5-0 voting by the supervisors filled these positions. Mr. Klonis asked for the nominations for Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. Ms. Ciotti nominated Dr. Ganas. Mr. Barbieri seconded this motion. Ms. Kircher then nominated Ms. Starr but this nomination was not seconded. The vote was 3-2 in favor of Dr. Ganas for appointment as Chairman. Dr. Ganas eliminated the tie by voting in favor of his appointment. Opposed were supervisors Starr and Kircher. Following the appointment of the chair. Mr. Barbieri made nomination of Ms. Ciotti as Vice Chairman and Ms. Starr seconded this. A unanimous vote by the supervisors completed the appointment of the Vice Chairman. All other appointments were made by unanimous decisions including the partial list below. The supervisors also decided to change the designation of Highway Foreman to Highway Assistant Superintendent to more accurately reflect the

duties and responsibilities of the position held by George Spaner. No pay increase is associated with the change in title.

Other business decided was the setting of the bond limits of \$1 Million a piece for the Treasurer and the Assistant Treasurer. The Township 2006 Wage Resolution reviewed was made and obtained a vote of 5-0 for approval. Advertising was authorized for the following during 2006: Seasonal Requirements, Fuels, Line Painting and Intersection Painting. The supervisors also expressed some concern about scheduled meetings for 2006 and adjusted the calendar to reflect the necessary changes. The meeting was adjourned and the Board of Supervisors completed necessary signing of forms and interacted with residents.
